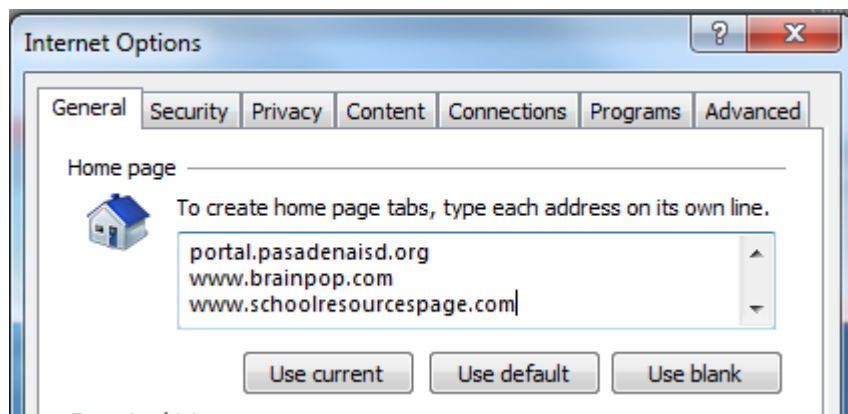


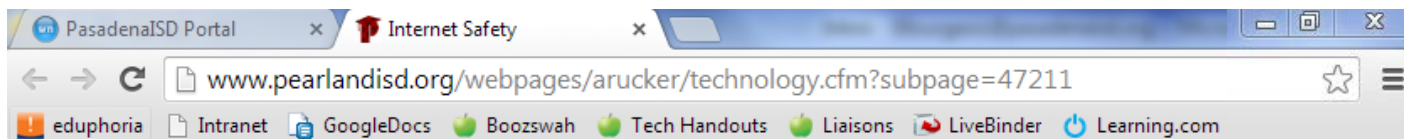
Setting Home Page(s) in Internet Explorer (IE)

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Go to Tools→Internet Options
3. Click the General Tab (if necessary)
4. Enter the web addresses that you want to auto-open when IE is opened.
5. Type each address on its own line.
6. Press Enter after each address.
7. The top line (address) will be the first tab that appears.
8. Click OK



Setting the Home Page(s) in Google Chrome

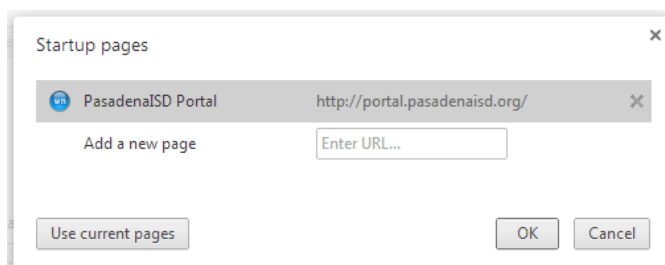
1. Open Google Chrome
2. Click the Customize and Control Google Chrome button at the top right



3. Click Settings
4. Under “On startup”, click “Open a specific page or set of pages.”
5. Click the “**Set pages**” link
6. A URL (address) probably already appears on the first line
7. Click the first address
8. Enter the web addresses that you want to auto-open when Google Chrome is opened
9. Press Enter
10. Enter the next URL tab that you want to appear
11. Press Enter
12. Continue adding a new page until all URL addresses are added
13. Click OK
