SIZE OF PROJECT:

- How many people/students will be impacted?
- Where will the impact be? Campus? District?

SCOPE OF PROJECT:

- Has this project or similar been done before?
- How long will it take to solve this problem?

DATA COLLECTION:

- What data will I need to show success
- How will I collect this data?

SUSTAINABILITY:

- Is this a one-time project? Or will continue long-term?
- How will the project continue once funding?
