Elementary Dress Code (as stated in Student Code of Conduct)

Shirts

- Any color to include prints, stripes, plaids, pictures and logos
- Free of inappropriate designs, appropriately sized with sleeves
- School Spirit shirts can be worn any day of the week

Pants/Capri Pants/Shorts

- Any color to include prints, stripes, plaids, pictures and logos
- Free of inappropriate design, hemmed, and appropriately sized (fitted and worn at the waist, shorts no higher than two inches above the kneecap)
- Free of holes, tears or slits

Dresses/Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers (female students only)

- Any color to include prints, stripes, plaids, and pictures
- Free of inappropriate design, hemmed, and appropriately sized (fitted and worn at the waist, no higher than 2 inches above the kneecap) and dresses with sleeves
- Free of holes and tears
- Manufacturer slits can come no higher than 2 inches above the kneecap

Students will participate in physical education activities with the clothes they wear to school.

Shoes

- Students must wear shoes with backs and be fastened at all times.
- Skate shoes are not permitted.

Students participating in physical education activities must have appropriate shoes.

Sweaters/Sweat Shirts/Light Jackets/Hoodies

- Any color
- Free of inappropriate designs, appropriately sized

Coats (Elementary Schools) - Placed in an area designated by the teacher upon arrival

Hair/Jewelry/Cosmetics

- Hair must be neat, clean and have no shaved designs.
- Any student may wear earrings as long as the earrings are not a safety hazard or distraction.
- Elementary girls - Nail polish is acceptable, but no artificial nails and no other cosmetics are allowed.

Backpacks must be transparent or mesh and free of inappropriate designs.

All other rules/regulations as defined in the Student Code of Conduct, regarding dress and grooming shall apply.

An Overview of CHAMPS/DSC: A Proactive & Positive Approach to Classroom Management

Student misbehavior continues to be a leading frustration for teachers and a drain on instructional time. CHAMPS Classroom Management (and the corollary, Discipline in the Secondary Classroom) is designed to help any educator develop or fine-tune an effective classroom management plan for grades K-12. Participants will learn and discuss classroom management strategies that improve the classroom climate and reduce disruptions in both socially distanced face-to-face and virtual learning environments.

The CHAMPS approach emphasizes the use of clear expectations and positive relationships to increase student motivation and reduce off-task behavior during instruction and independent work periods in the classroom and online.
