- has performed satisfactorily on an applicable subject area test of the State High School equivalency examination; or
- provides evidence of attainment of an industry recognized post-secondary license or certification; or
- provide evidence of current active duty service in armed forces or a DD Form 214 indicating honorable or general discharge; or
- has earned college credit post-secondary in the failed testing area.

If the student does not qualify in the above criteria, the student must complete the following district alternative criteria to receive a diploma.

- I. The student has passed all curriculum requirements for graduation per SBOE rule.
