March 27, 2012

BUSINESS ITEMS

At the Pasadena ISD Board of Trustees regular meeting for the month of March, the Board approved the following:

- A fee of \$1,500 for interns who enroll in the Alternative Teacher Certification Program and the continuation of a waiver of the \$3,000 balance for training costs for interns who commit to three years of employment in the district.
- Revisions to the Student Code of Conduct for 2012-2013.
- Dance Performance Ensemble 1 & 2, a state approved innovative course, to be offered at all five district high-school campuses.
- A contract with the Harris County Protective Services for Children and Adults Community Youth Services to provide consultant services for The Summit.
- A contract with the International Center for Leadership in Education for 20 days of consulting services at Miller Intermediate.
- A grant-funded, one-to-one technology program for Miller Intermediate.

- An Extended Year plan for Summer 2012.
- G/T Summer Exploration Camps for 2012.
- Acceptance of \$258,600 in grant dollars from the Texas Support for Homeless and (TEXSHEP) McKinney-Vento programs.
- Participation by Career and Technical Education students to participate in national competitions during the spring and summer of 2012.
- Travel for two Sam Rayburn High CASE students and two chaperones to attend the 2012 Afterschool for All Challenge in Washington D.C. in May.
- Suspended portions of Board Policy related to the implementation of End of Course examination requirements that such examinations count for 15 percent of a student's final course grade, the action taken with the permission of the Commissioner of Education.
- The purchase of property adjacent to Milstead Middle School, to be used for a second gymnasium and additional playground space, at a cost of \$585,000.
- The purchase of property to be used for the construction of a new South Shaver Elementary campus, at a cost of \$575,000.
- Construction funding for portable additions to Dobie High School, at a cost of \$370,000.
- Construction funding for renovations to the Braden Center to accommodate expansion of Community School, at a cost of \$300,000.
- A schematic design for New Middle School No. 11 and the new Keller Middle School project.
- Schematic designs and budgets for the construction of new gymnasiums at South Houston High and at Sam Rayburn High.
