



# ToonDoo – Comic Strip Creator

<h2 style="text-align: center;">Creating Your Account</h2>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Go to <a href="http://www.toondoo.com/">http://www.toondoo.com/</a></li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Click </li> <li>3. Choose Sign up for ToonDoo (free version)</li> <li>4. Enter a username, password and the email you want to use with this tool.</li> <li>5. Click Register - You should see the following message:             <div style="border: 1px dashed black; background-color: #ffffcc; padding: 5px; text-align: center; margin: 10px 0;"> <p style="color: red; font-weight: bold;">Congratulations! <h2 style="text-align: center;">Logging In and Using ToonDoo</h2> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Go to <a href="http://www.toondoo.com">http://www.toondoo.com</a></li> <li>2. Click </li> <li>3. Click the Layout (horizontal or vertical) to choose the number of “scenes” you want</li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Hover over the scene options on the left to reveal items you can add to your scenes.</li> <li>5. Click the choice from the menu to populate the gallery</li> <li>6. Drag the item from the gallery to add it to your scene on the right</li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>7. Click an item in one of the scenes on the right to select it (you will see the dotted lines around it).</li> <li>8. Click the tools along the bottom to edit it. You can change the size, orientation, placement, etc.             <div style="border: 1px solid gray; background-color: #e0e0e0; padding: 5px; margin: 10px 0;">  </div> </li> <li>9. 

**If you would like to display your Toon as a webpage ONLY for a specific person to see, do the following:**

18. Click Share with friends! (at the bottom)
19. Enter the person(s) email address (separate each email with a comma)
20. Click Publish
21. Click OK
22. The email with which you shared your Toon will receive an email that looks like the email pictured below. He/she can click the Toon icon to open the cartoon.
