

HCPH COVID-19 VACCINATIONS FOR AGES 12-17

**Harris County Public Health has begun Pfizer vaccinations
for residents between the ages of 12-17!**

- Schedule an appointment via (832) 927-8787 or through [VacsTrac](#). Appointments are recommended, but not required
- Parents who register their children through ReadyHarris.org, must choose the NRG Park location (Pfizer) when given the option to schedule the appointment
- Parents or guardians, who do not accompany their child, need to sign a Parental Consent Form to authorize their children get the vaccine
- If children between 12-17 go to the vaccination site without an appointment, parents must accompany the child to provide verbal or written consent - the [Parental Consent Form](#) will be provided

**Residents between the ages of 12-17 who do not have a
Parent Consent Form or a Parent/Guardian with them to
provide verbal consent will not receive a vaccination.**
